Subsequent to the termination of U.S. military operations in Iraq, the State Department will no longer expedite license or approval requests submitted in support of Operation New Dawn (OND). This new policy will take effect on **December 26, 2011**. The State Department will continue to expedite requests for exports in direct support of coalition efforts in Afghanistan for Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF).
